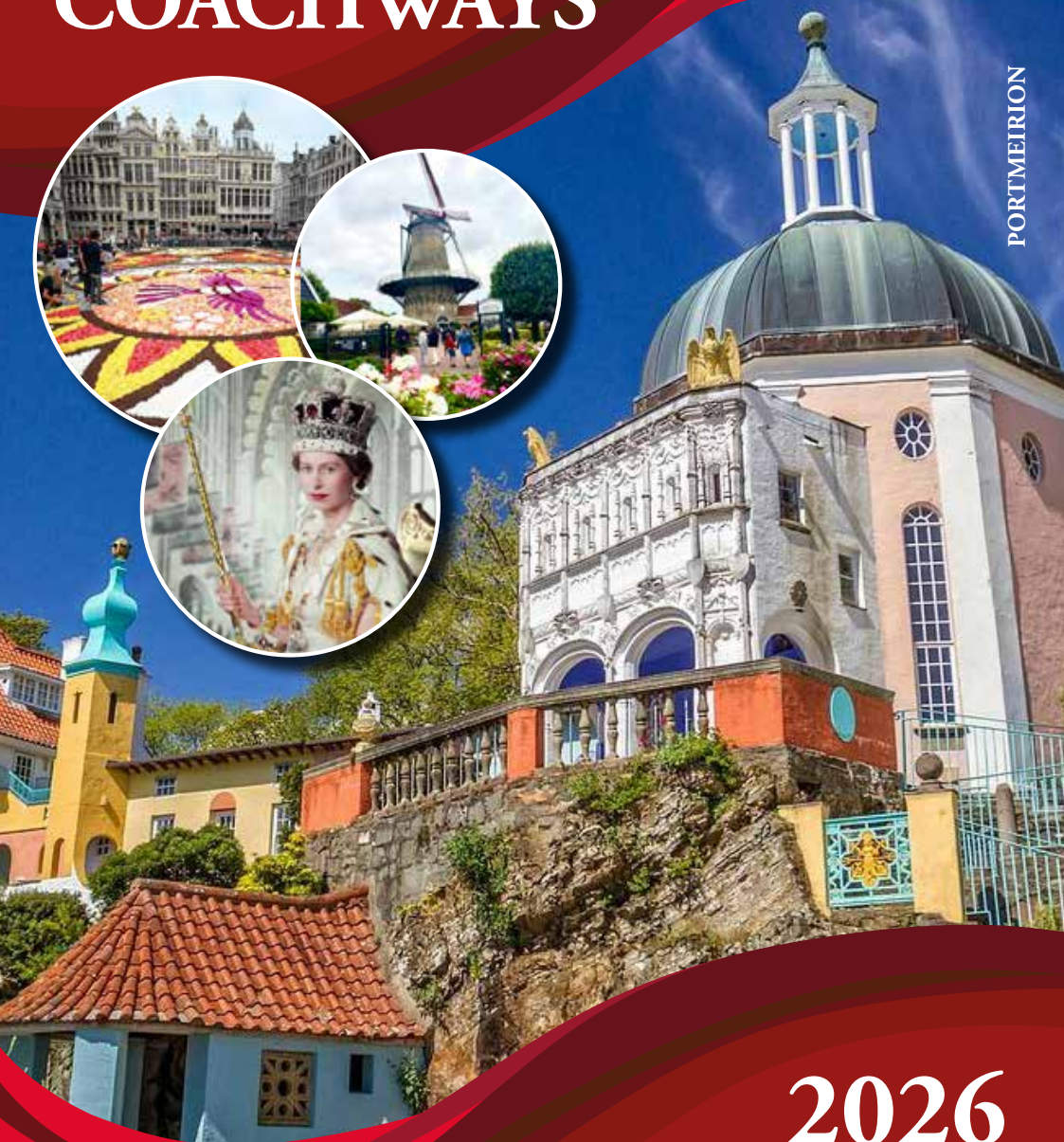

LIVERPOOL & NORTHERN DELIGHTS

The City offers the opportunity to be transported back to the Swinging Sixties with its vibrant music scene. On Tuesday take a Beatles tour with a Blue Badge guide and visit Crosby Beach to see the spectacular sculptures by Antony Gormley, his work 'Another Place' consists of 100 cast-iron, life-size figures spread out along three kilometres of the foreshore, stretching almost one kilometre out to sea.

Visitors will be spoilt for choice with Liverpool's exceptional museums, art galleries, shopping and dining experiences.

On Wednesday we travel to Salford Quays, Manchester and the opportunity for you to visit the **Lowry Gallery** and the **Imperial War Museum North** (entries inclusive).

Garden lovers will enjoy a visit to **RHS Bridgewater Garden**. The RHS's newest garden continues to evolve with the contemporary Welcome Garden and the walled Paradise Garden with its inspiring blend of Mediterranean and Asiatic planting which leads to the Chinese Streamside Garden. (Entry £17 RHS Members free)

The tour is based at the superb The Liner Hotel (3* B/B) in the heart of the city.



KEW GARDENS

Sunday 9th August

There's so much to see and do at Kew Gardens. Summer is a special time, every corner is alive with colour. Stop at the Rose Garden to admire the colours and scents and be dazzled by the Great Broad Walk Borders. Explore the Princess of Wales Conservatory and take a tree-top walk. Step back in time and visit Kew Palace – home of George III



CITIES OF CULTURE BRUSSELS CARPET OF FLOWERS

Friday 14th – Tuesday 18th August

Our tour to Flanders features visits to exceptional Cities of Culture and Art including the unique Carpet of Flowers in Brussels.

Brussels - A mix of historic grandeur and futuristic buildings. Our coach tour visits the European Parliament Quarter, the Atomium, Parc de Brussels and Mont des Arts. Later you can visit the impressive Galeries Royales Saint-Hubert before priority viewing of the spectacular Carpet of Flowers in the Grand Place which is considered to be the most beautiful Square in the World!

Brugge - The Venice of the North with its web of canals, historic buildings, museums, galleries and chocolate shops. We feature a horse-drawn tour by historic tram that winds its way from the Market Square and Belfry through the cobbled streets of the City.

Kortrijk - A unique UNESCO town with a host of attractions including the International Rose Garden and the historic Beguinage (entry inclusive).

Sluis - We cross the border into Holland to this charming town where you can enjoy boutique stores, cozy cafes and a relaxed scenic setting complete with Windmill.

Lens - In the Great War, 90% of the town was destroyed and the majority of the architecture dates from the 1920s and includes a number of art deco buildings. The highlight of our visit will be to the former Miners' Village which is now the location of the Louvre-Lens Museum. Two gallery spaces display over 250 works of art from the Louvre in Paris (entry inclusive).

Travel via DFDS Dover to Dunkirk Ferry. Based at the superb Mercure Metropole Hotel Lille. 4* Deluxe. (BB)



WINDSOR & LONDON GO AS YOU PLEASE

Friday 28th – Sunday 30th August

On Friday an extended visit to Royal Windsor where you can visit the Castle, Saville Gardens (entry fees extra), take a Thames River Cruise or stroll to nearby Eton with its famous college, charming antique shops, galleries and cafes.

On Saturday and Sunday we feature a London coach tour and the opportunity to visit locations of your choice including the Kensington Museums, Imperial War Museum and the famous Art Galleries. For theatre-goers, you may wish to attend matinee performances of your choice (extra cost). The tour is based at the popular 4* Holiday Inn Heathrow and includes English breakfast and Dinner on both evenings.



MARKET DAY IN WELLS

THE PRE-HISTORIC WAY AND OXFORD

Avebury Village is a unique setting with thatched cottages and Georgian town houses encircled by the largest pre-historic stone circle in Europe. Avebury Manor is a 16th century country house where rooms are dressed to reflect different periods of its history from Tudor to the 20th century (*entry inclusive*). Our drive from Avebury to the popular market town of Marlborough passes a number of pre-historic mounds and burial chambers.

We visit Oxford with opportunities to visit the Pitt Rivers Museum or the Ashmolean Museum and Gallery or take an optional walking tour of the famous colleges.

WARNERS BODELWYDDAN CASTLE & PORTMEIRION

Designed by visionary architect Sir Clough Williams-Ellis, it's a kaleidoscope of pastel-coloured buildings, ornate gardens, and sweeping estuary views. Filming location of the 1960s TV series *The Prisoner* (entry inclusive).
